

PREVENT

As you may be aware, the Counter Terrorism and Security Act 2015 places reporting requirements on schools and academies.

At Loughton, Green, Rebekah Green has undertaken WRAP (Workshop to Raise Awareness of Prevent) training, and is in possession of her WRAP facilitator reference numbers. This allows her to train the rest of the school staff in how to remain vigilant for all forms of terrorism or extremism, and where to report such signs and concerns should they arise. In addition, Andy George, Headteacher, has received specific PREVENT training from Milton Keynes Safeguarding Board. All staff have now received PREVENT training from the school.

Counter Terrorism and Security Act 2015 - Prevent Duty Guidance

The Bill places a duty on specified authorities to have “due regard to the need to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism”.

This involves:

- Responding to the ideological challenge of terrorism
- Preventing people from being drawn into terrorism
- Working with sectors and institutions where there are risks of radicalisation
- Specified Authorities
- Local authorities
- Police
- Prisons
- Young offender institutions
- Providers of probation services
- Schools/Colleges/Universities
- NHS bodies
