Curriculum

At Loughton, we aim to provide a rich, creative, inclusive, challenging and real-world curriculum that inspires all our children and adults alike. This immersive approach promotes engagement for all learners and encourages children to become ever more curious and active in their own learning. Our lessons actively promote the children to solve problems, develop effective communication skills with their peers and share their thinking. We use environmental stimuli to enrich a child's learning experience. As part of our thematic learning, the year group shared areas change with each project that we do so that it truly immerses the children in a place, time or event.

Alongside our excellent foundation teaching, we pride ourselves on offering a wide range of topics and subjects. We offer specialist teaching for sports, art and design, music, drama and dance and modern foreign languages, with all children having these lessons weekly. There is also the opportunity for children to learn a musical instrument from a wide range on offer.

To enhance our immersive curriculum, children have termly trips and visits to bring their learning to life outside of the school and enhance learning with real life experiences, with visits to places such as KidZania, The Tower of London and Bletchley Park to name a few.

Clubs & Teams

We offer an impressive range of school clubs, run by members of our Loughton staff from all areas of the school family. Each term, we offer approximately 30 clubs. The clubs on offer vary and have included choir, drama, coding and science. Club times may vary and are held after school or at lunch time in order to accommodate everyone. Currently, 80% of children enjoy a club each term.

The school also has many sports teams which children may choose or be invited to join including athletics, hockey, football, badminton, cricket and rounders, many of which have inter-school competitions with 75% of children representing the school in fixtures and various festivals.

Our children have a strong voice which is really listened to. We host and promote many student voice groups. These include our School Council, Junior Road Safety Officers, Green Team, Digi leaders and LS News. These are an excellent way for children to learn about speaking up and making a difference to their community.
