## ‘My Activity Passport’!

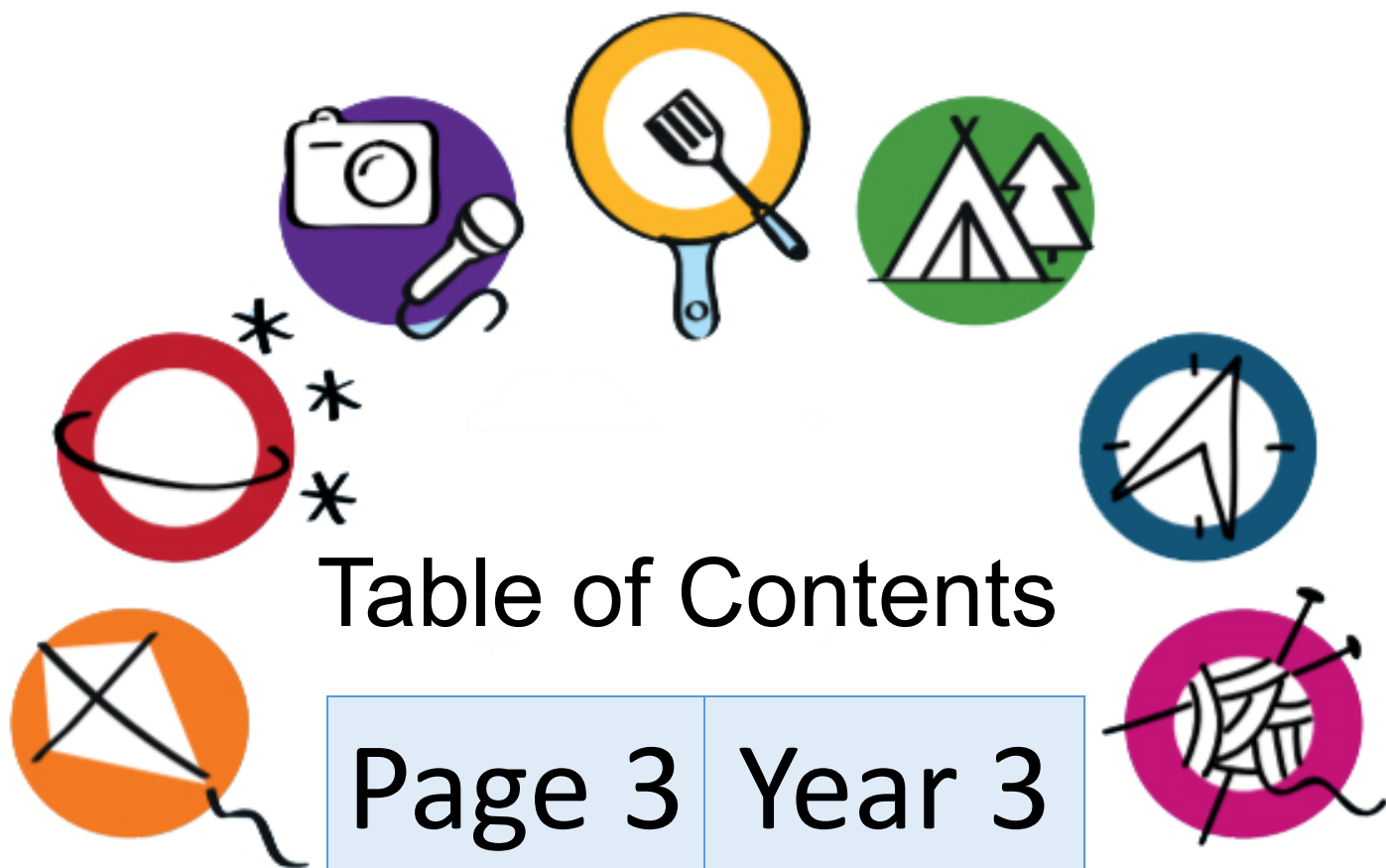
