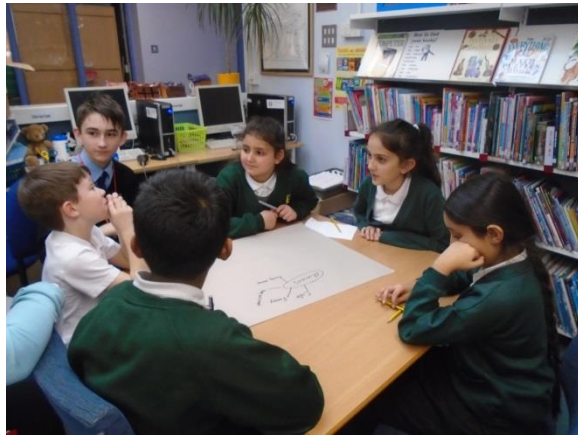


Meeting Denbigh's School Council
