

At Loughton, DT:

- is taught in each year group.
- includes a cooking unit in each year group.
- is taught through a range of topics including; mechanisms, textiles, food technology and electrical systems.
- encourages problem solving and critical thinking.
- is practical.
- encourages children to choose from a range of tools to fit the purpose (for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing).
- is enriched in technical knowledge.
- encourages children to cooperate and contribute in a group to ensure team success.
- is made up of 3 phases: designing, making and evaluating.
- relates to everyday life to give meaning to the children's learning.


At Loughton, STEM:


- is the embellishment of DT.

- develops strong links between our immersive curriculum and prior learning.

- encourages children to express their <u>creativity</u>.
- emphases the importance of safety and <u>respect</u> when handling specialised tools
- encourages children to use the skills learnt the previous year to develop <u>independence</u> and <u>resilience</u>.


