Sorry to hear you're going

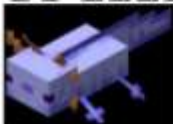

HOW TO MAKE A ORIGAMI CLAW

Bored? Have a bunch of spare paper on your hands? Want to say you have done origami but don't have the patience to make something time-consuming? Try making a paper claw!

You Will Need:

A rectangular piece of paper

Fingers (preferable yours)

That's it!

Steps:

Put the paper landscape (long sides on the top and bottom)

Fold the top 2 corners down to the middle

Fold the bottom corners to meet the new flaps

Take the bottom corners and fold them up

Fold the paper in half from the left to right

Unfold that, it will be a guide for the next step

Fold the top left corner so the straight side lines up with the crease you

made last step

Fold it again ONCE so that it is like you are rolling it up

Can you see an upside-down arrow?

Good!

About 2/3 from the bottom up, there is a pocket, wiggle your finger about, in the pocket, to make it nice and roomy

See the bit on the left? Fold it into the little pocket you made last step

On the top third, there is a little pocket on the side. Stick your finger in there and - hey presto! - you should have a paper claw like the one in the picture!

GOOD JOB! YOU HAVE MADE A

PAPER CLAW! You can repeat these steps to get 10 fingers worth or you can stack them to make doubles!
