## Staffing

As a minimum we operate a 1:8 staffing ratio. All staff are employed directly by Loughton School and are trained in food hygiene, fire safety, first aid and safeguarding procedures.

Please be assured that all staff are fully DBS Enhanced checked.

Each week the club will have a specific and exciting theme.

From this, a selection of activities will be available within each session.

These will range from physical activity or sport, arts and crafts, music appreciation, performing arts, cooking, life skills and ICT skills.

## Booking

Online bookings and payments can be made via our dedicated online system called Tucasi.

Should you not have access to an online system then please pay in cash at the School Office.

All payment should be made in advance and we are unable to issue refunds should your child be absent for any reason.

We are also able to accept childcare vouchers from many different providers.

Priority will be given to those booking After School Club for a full week; however, if space is available we are prepared to accept bookings for only a few weekly sessions.

We recognise that just occasionally a need for emergency childcare may arise and will try to ensure that we accommodate this as far as possible.

## External School Provision

Walking buses (whereby the children walk to Loughton School with an accompanying adult) from Loughton Manor First School and Glastonbury Thorn School will operate under the care of experienced staff. This facility will be for those children in years 1 and 2 who require it. This will be at no additional cost.

## Evening Meal

We will provide a tasty and nutritious two course meal, prepared and cooked on site, which encourages children to eat healthily and on some days the children will be able to help prepare the food.

## Cost and Hours

After School Club operates between 3:00pm and 6:00pm, Monday to Friday during school term time. Parents can collect their children at any time within this period but please note that snack will be served at 4.30pm.

Cost per session is £13.35 with a 10% discount for siblings.

## What we offer

## Staffing

## Cost and Hours

Breakfast Club operates between 7:30am and 8:45am, Monday to Friday during school term time. Parents can drop off their children at any time within this period but please note that breakfast will not be served after 8:20am.

## External schools

The walking bus (whereby the children walk to Glastonbury Thorn School with an accompanying adult) from Loughton School will operate under the care of experienced staff. This facility will be for those children in years 1 and 2 who require it. This will be at no additional cost.

## Booking
