<b>WORKING TOWARDS THE EXPECTED STANDARD</b>						
The pupil can:						
Use paragraphs to organise ideas						
In narratives, describe settings and characters using an appropriate adjective						
In non-narrative writing, use headings, sub-headings or bullet points to structure writing.						
Use capital letters, full stops & question marks, commas for lists and apostrophes for contraction mostly correctly						
Spell correctly some words from the year 3 / year 4 spelling list						
Write legibly						
<b>WORKING AT THE EXPECTED STANDARD</b>						
The pupil can:						
Use the features of a chosen text to write for purpose (e.g. the use of the first person in a diary/recount; direct address in instructions and persuasive writing, use of plot in narratives)						
In narratives, use basic description in <b>Setting</b> and <b>Character</b> and begin to develop a sense of <b>Atmosphere</b> in their writing.						
Begin to use dialogue to add interest in a narrative.						
Use <b>Conjunctions</b> , <b>Adverbs</b> and <b>Prepositions</b> to show time, place and cause. Avoids repetition and writing reads correctly.						
Use verb tenses correctly throughout their writing.						
Use a range of punctuation taught in year 4 <b>mostly</b> correctly: inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech, brackets or commas for parenthesis, exclamation marks, apostrophes for possession)						
Spell correctly most words from the year 3 / year 4 spelling list and begin to use a dictionary independently to check more adventurous spellings.						
Write legibly – joining if possible.						
<b>WORKING AT GREATER DEPTH</b>						
The pupil can:						
Use examples from their own reading to plan their own writing.						
Accurately use the full range of punctuation from the year 4 objectives across a range of pieces.						
Write cohesively and include ambitious vocabulary throughout to engage the reader.
