We know many of you have been following the Euros and two of our reporters—Aiden and Jamie—certainly have too! Here are a couple of pieces from them.



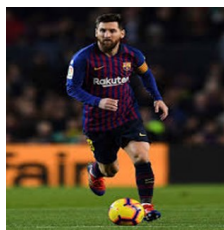
My favourite football player by Aiden

The church bells will ring



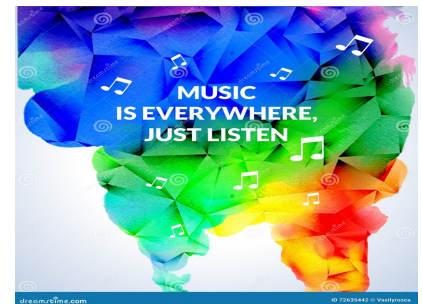

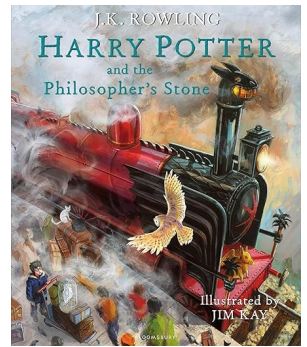
