Dear Parents/Carers

**Year 6 school trips and visits 2019-20**

We are delighted to update you about the trips and visits your child will be taking part in this academic year. Below is the schedule of events that will be happening throughout the year. As you are aware, some of these trips have already taken place. We have done this to allow for you to budget as we know trips can get expensive if you have more than one child.

Due to government legislation, we have to refer to the charge for these trips as a “voluntary contribution”. However, with the government cuts to school budgets, we will not be able to run these trips without your contribution. No child will be excluded from the trip if their parent/carer does not contribute, but if we do not receive enough contributions then we will be forced to cancel the trip. The Loughton PTSA (parents, teachers and students association) have kindly contributed towards some of the activities to reduce the cost of them further.

Nearer the time, there will be letters sent out giving you more information about the individual trips and visits and what the children will need to take with them.
